Caller: Sure you do. Squash the fibonacci sequence.

James: How do you squash the Fibonacci sequence?

Caller: By hitting Dan.

James: You squash the Fibonacci sequence by hitting Dan?

Ben: I'll call the police for you, Dan.

Dan: Thanks, man.
