BEN: Because he's mad!

PRODUCER: And HOW did he do that?

BEN: Latin water!

DAN: Right!

PRODUCER: My spa world tour was supposed to make me feel relaxed. How am I supposed to be relaxed now that you've told an absolutely CRAZY lie right to my face, as if I'm some kind of FOOL?!

JAMES: It's true. I'm a pigeon now.

PRODUCER: ... No...

JAMES: I'm just as surprised as you are. More even.

PRODUCER: You've attached a tiny microphone to the pigeon and got James to speak through it.

JAMES: (Sadly) If only.

PRODUCER: This is a dream.

DAN: Believe you me, I tell myself that, ALL the time.

BEN: Me too.

JAMES: I honestly wish this WAS a dream...

DAN: With all due respect Sir, I think it's best you just get used to James being a bird.

PRODUCER: I shouldn't have to!

BEN: Let's just talk about Lego. Take your mind off things...

JAMES: How about you help me?!

DAN: No.

JAMES: Help me or I'll learn Latin!

DAN: You dare!!

PRODUCER: You know what?

DAN: What?

PRODUCER: Part of me knew this would happen.

DAN: Really??

PRODUCER: Yes. Which is why I'm going to completely ignore this situation and not let it get the best of me.

BEN: What are you doing, boss? What are you getting from your pocket?

PRODUCER: I've brought some items with me, that I think will be very helpful...

DAN: What's going on?

PRODUCER: I've bought a Lego poster with me, and I'm going to point at it. So. How do the images make you feel? What do they want to make you do?

DAN: Play with Lego?

PRODUCER: That's a start. What in particular do you want to build?

DAN: Star Wars Lego?

PRODUCER: Anything else?

DAN: Hm.

BEN: Er...

JAMES: (Cheerfully) How about... A Star Wars pigeon!?

PRODUCER: Is that the best you can do? You're supposed to be professionals!

DAN: We're sorry, but since James... changed, none of us know what to think anymore... It's like our worlds have been turned upside down!

PRODUCER: (Nervously) I know what you mean...

DAN: Right!

PRODUCER: Is there a cure?

DAN: Now, now. Maybe we can profit off James's... new style...

PRODUCER: Go on...

DAN: All I'm saying is, having a pigeon give his comments is a very striking new angle.

BEN: Yeah!

JAMES: Coo.

DAN: You're going to have to try harder than that, James.

JAMES: No.

PRODUCER: Yeah, this is working out beautifully...

DAN: Just hit James a bit, that'll get a reaction. It will be very entertaining.

JAMES: I'll peck your goddamn eye out.

PRODUCER: This isn't the kind of show I want to make. Not at all.

DAN: But...

PRODUCER: No buts. I've given you chance, after chance, after chance.

BEN: (Nervously) Terminator Lego is pretty cool...

DAN: Yes! But you'd think as the film is for 15 year olds at least, children wouldn't understand what the Lego was about. Why does a Terminator Lego model have a half robot, half human face for example? Isn't that random?

BEN: Right. A full robot wouldn't be weird, but a half-robot face, as you pointed out,

Dan? That's as weird as a half-bird-person. Like you used to be, James. Before the full conversion, I mean. You've been powned. Bellend.

JAMES: (Expletive) you.

PRODUCER: Well that's it, isn't it? This podcast is finished once and for all. I would say it was nice while it lasted, but that would be ridiculous.

DAN: Sir, please! We're just stressed!

JAMES: YOU'RE stressed?? I'm thinking about seeds 24/7!

PRODUCER: Stress in a podcast is completely normal. You should be able to handle it.

DAN: Not THIS much stress!! You know James! He's demented! How are we supposed to react??

PRODUCER: With the same level of professionalism as me.

(A phone rings)

BE: Hello?

CALLER: Can you film James again, please?

DAN: Don't you see what this means, boss?

PRODUCER: What?

DAN: It means all we have to do is sit back, as this bird here creates the most viewed freak show known to man!

CALLER: I want to see James peck everyone. I want to see violence. I want to see blood.

PRODUCER: I don't know...

DAN: It will be a breeze...

PRODUCER: Sounds a bit... Illegal...

CALLER: Go for the eyes, it's a weak spot.

PRODUCER: Cut him off.

BEN: Done.

PRODUCER: Again, this is nothing like my vision. Now that I know the kind of audience we're attracting, it makes me feel sick.

DAN: He was probably a one off! Most listeners probably have a completely healthy interest in the offbeat.

(A phone rings)

CALLER 2: Peck the veins on the neck. It will cause severe blood loss.

PRODUCER: That's it. Podcast over.
