JAMES: You did help me.

DAN: You've done it again! Do you have any idea how mad people are at you?

JAMES: And you.

DAN: Apologise. Apologise right now.

JAMES: What do you want me to say?

DAN: Do you even know what an apology is?

BEN: You should do, how did you get your judge to feel sorry for you?

JAMES: I powned him.

JAMES: That's just something you'll have to live with.

CALLER: I'm fed up with this!

JAMES: Look, if someone speaks the language to you, just put your fingers in your ears.

CALLER: And what if he sign languages it to me?

DAN: NO!

CALLER: I've given people ideas, haven't I?

JAMES: Apologise.

CALLER: You what?

JAMES: I'm sorry.

BEN: Well done, James. You handled that well. I hung up for you.

JAMES: A new word, a new friend.

(The phone rings)

JAMES: Hello?

(Revvng is heard)

JAMES: Can razors be used as apple peelers? Maybe they can...

BEN: That would be flaying.

JAMES: It's ok. You're safe here.

CALLER 3: You're a joke.

BEN: Thanks.
