Today, I'll be reviewing Saturday Night Wrist, by Deftones! Sadly if you want to buy a copy of it on Amazon, you'll have to get it second hand. You know why I think that is? The title. It's actually the name of a condition where you sleep on your wrist (often on Saturday night after drunken partying) and when you wake up, you've messed your arm up. 'Ooh an album about sleeping on your arm.' Not exactly exciting is it? Here's a name for an album: Sprained Knee. The album opens with track 'Hole in the Earth'. I'm a huge fan of Deftones obviously, but Deftones... please don't go down that road.

It's not all bad though, other tracks include 'Cherry Waves'. Oh if only waves were made of cherries. Salt water? Waves that dehydrate you? In a way I guess that's for the best though as if waves were made of cherries, everyone would eat them and there would be no more waves to surf on. Great news for countries at risk of tsunamis, though. There's a tsunami coming? Deploy the team of hungry people. Another song is called 'Beware'. Beware the team of hungry people? We can conclude Deftones love surfing and want to keep the sport alive. If there was a threat of the local go kart track being eaten by people, I'd tell others to beware of that, too. I could write a song about it if people wouldn't believe what I said, songs have more impact than words alone as they are catchy, I think. That would be 'Cherry Go Karts'. Another song is called 'Rats!Rats!Rats!' You know why I think the band are angry enough to say 'rats!' three times? Their spacebar is broken. I'd hate it if my spacebar was broken, I'd be screwed. Angry enough to type rats three times!

Track 'Kimdracula' I'm assuming is about someone like Dracula, but called Kimberly. The band are going in the wrong direction, again. Not as bad as writing about adorable animals digging holes, but how big of an audience would Kimberly Dracula have? Ooh scared. Similarly, would the Terminator be as scary if it wore a pink dress? Same goes for Hannibal Lecter. Track 'U,U,D,D,L,R,L,R,A,B,Select,Start' is a NES cheat that I think gives you more lives.
