DAN: Ahhh. Of course!

BEN: James, I should report you to the police...

DAN: You think you know someone...

JAMES: But it all worked out in the end, right?

DAN: Even so, countless people died!

JAMES: I'm sorry!

BEN: What else are you responsible for??

JAMES: I started World War 1, too.

BEN: Not ANOTHER war?

DAN: James, have you actually done anything good?

JAMES: I invented penicillin.

DAN: For all the people you wounded?

JAMES: That was at least something.

DAN: If you really want to put things right, why not undo the wars, right now?

JAMES: I could do. But what if I do so and everything changes? Ever heard of the butterfly effect? Even tiny actions can have huge consequences...

BEN: It's the right thing to do.

JAMES: Ok. I've telepathically undone the wars...

BEN: James!

JAMES: What??

BEN: You're starting to disappear!

JAMES: I KNEW this would happen!!

DAN: Again, you did the right thing...

BEN: He's gone...

DAN: I'm really going to miss him...

JAMES: Oooooooo.....

DAN: What was that? Is there a ghost in here?

BEN: I think we're being haunted...

JAMES: Oooooo....

BEN: This is the scariest thing to happen to anyone since... well not World War One, as there hasn't been a world war, yet. The scariest thing to happen since...

DAN: Since the beginning of time...

JAMES: Yes! I mean oooooooooo.

DAN: I think to calm the ghost down, we should welcome it and give it a nice warm cup of coffee...

BEN: Great idea.

JAMES: No!! Back off!

DAN: The ghost will go insane?

JAMES: How did you know??

DAN: Never mind. Hey, Ben?

BEN: What?

DAN: Did you hear about that ghost that's been haunting this station recently?

BEN: Yeah?

DAN: Turns out he's an asshole AND he started all diseases! Coronavirus, too. That's going to tick a lot of people off.

JAMES: Not again!

BEN: How did he do that?

DAN: I don't know. But people are getting angry!

BEN: I bet!

JAMES: Argh!

DAN: You can understand why, though. I mean... fancy causing ALL disease. And lockdown? That's been driving people crazy for a LONG time. There's already talk of a full blown riot. I can sense it.

BEN: But how are people supposed to get vengeance on a ghost you can't even see?

DAN: The rioters will be summoning the Wooble Dooble...

BEN: The Wooble Dooble? That's the dumbest thing I've heard in my life.

DAN: (Whispering) Just go with it...

BEN: Ok. What's the Wooble Dooble?

DAN: An unstoppable ghost destroyer!

JAMES: (Expletive!)

DAN: Hey... Did you hear that?

BEN: What?

DAN: I think the Wooble Dooble is here, now... I can sense him...

BEN: Yes! Me too...

DAN: I can feel him possessing me! He's making me speak...

JAMES: Oh my God!

DAN: Where's the ghost of James? He's gonna die!

(Thudding sound)

DAN: James just punched me in the face!

BEN: Jeez! That was quite a blow!

DAN: I'm bleeding!

BEN: You might want to get that looked at...

DAN: OW!

BEN: Not sure why James is hiding in the corner if we're not supposed to be able to see him...

(A phone rings)

BEN: I'll answer that...

DAN: Arrrrgh!

CALLER: Hello? I'm really confused. I've heard of World War 1 AND 2. Am I crazy?

BEN: I think things have gone too far...

DAN: No! This is the funniest day of my life!

CALLER: Personally I heard diabetes was caused by too much sugar. I'm not sure how you can blame the ghost of James for THAT...

DAN: Lies spread by the media.

CALLER: Oh.

DAN: Caller, what do you think should be done about James?

CALLER: I think we should study him so we can cure all of the diseases he's been spreading. Of course I feel like a fool for studying medicine at university for 3 years, only to find out the course was a load of rubbish, but at the same time I'm excited. I think James has the answer to make the world a safer place! And killing hundreds of millions of people? Everyone makes mistakes. Sorry, but I started the hundred years war. At least James's ones were over relatively quickly.

JAMES: Thanks, man.

BEN: Another crazy person...

DAN: Actually I think most of our audience are crazy. We really can blame THAT on James.

BEN: Listeners are listeners.

DAN: I guess. Well thanks for calling. You weren't as entertaining as I'd hoped, but callers are callers as Ben would say. He just did in fact.

BEN: Well that's all we have time for. Hope this show has been entertaining...

JAMES: No!

BEN: Byeeee!

DAN: (Annoyed) Bye!
