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So.... I'm going to review 'Slipknot' by Slipknot. How did I hear about this album? Well, I'm over 20 years old, so that means I've seen whole armies of people wearing this band's hoodies. If you're a certain age, and you haven't heard about this group, you're either blind (then how are you reading this), deaf-blind (eek, I feel for you), or you're demented. If you're all three, then... Wow. Still, you can eat pizza, always look on the bright side of life, and all that. Moving on, because of music loving youngsters who have a love-hate relationship with their eardrums, and go out of their way to destroy them, you have probably heard this music blasting out of some place, or another, as well.

Let's cut to the chace, this is some hateful music. I'm liking it, quite frankly. I think it would be pretentious to say that the lyrics here, have some deep meaning, however. At least no deeper than 'fuck off'. And there sure are a lot of 'fucks' here... 'Fuck you all', 'fuck this shit', 'fuck it all', and other variants. My word. 'Surfacing' has the highest concentration of expletives in its chorus. It goes like this: 'Fuck it all! Fuck this world! Fuck everything that you stand for! Don't belong! Don't exist! Don't give a shit! Don't ever judge me!' You don't want people to judge you? You're not making things easy for yourself. Especially as you're screaming your head off. If he wore a helmet and bullet proof vest, that would make at least some sense); there are two people with metal faces, and the last man has quite rightly been attacked with a large number of nails. Am I supposed to be scared? I wouldn't be scared of these people, if they came at me with a chainsaw, and shouted 'fuck' over and over and over, again. I'm presuming their sight would be severely impaired, and they'd probably trip over their baggy clothes, anyway. A guy dressed as a sausage roll, however? Now that's freaky! Why would a sausage attack? What would it do? 'I'm sorry?...', I hear you ask... It's just a thought I've been working on. Hear me out. All I'm saying, is creepy masks have been done. Food

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masks haven't.

So, what if these people dressed as sausages, instead? Imagine what their live shows would be like! I'm guessing the only reason they don't dress the way I want them to, is because that would GENUINELY be creepy. Their so called fans would drop like flies; I know you're thinking the same thing, too. In case you're wondering, I once got ill from eating a raw sausage. I guess the experience stayed with me. What would I do, to improve the album, itself? I'm pretty happy with it, actually. I would make the singer sing more, instead of shout, but shouting is good, as well. I guess some shred guitar solos would be appreciated, like the ones found in their later albums. Apparently, the reason why there are no wigouts on their debut, is because the producer, didn't want them. If only Slipknot dressed up as... Oh, never mind. What else...
