Familiar Person

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INT. GYM - DAY

Disco music blasts out. SIMON (33), excellent dress sense, is running on a treadmill at great speeds. A number of running GYM MEMBERS are on both his sides. In front of SIMON are OTHER MEMBERS on mats doing press ups, burpees, etc. In front of them is a door. The door opens to reveal a FAMILIAR PERSON in his 30s. He glances at SIMON briefly, then walks to an unoccupied treadmill on the far left. SIMON keeps on running as he occasionally glances at the NEWCOMER, past the other PEOPLE.

> SIMON (internal monologue) I swear I know that person who just looked at me... He's that deaf guy I met years ago...

A GYM MEMBER by SIMON's right comments as he runs.

GYM MEMBER Are you ok? You just keep staring into space...

SIMON I'm fine, thanks. Just got something on my mind...

The GYM MEMBER gives a thumbs up.

SIMON

(internal monologue) Maybe I should talk to the person and introduce myself. But what if I'm wrong and I'm getting him confused with someone else? No. I'm pretty sure it's him.

SIMON looks at the FAMILIAR PERSON for a couple of seconds and rubs his chin.

SIMON I know what to do. I could approach the guy from behind so he really notices me. Then he'll start talking to me...

SIMON leaves the treadmill and approaches the running FAMILIAR PERSON from behind. He gets ignored.

SIMON Hm. That didn't work. Maybe he's just shy. Maybe he'll talk to me once he builds up his confidence. SIMON turns round to see a number of WEIGHT LIFTERS beefing themselves up. SIMON picks up a weight for both hands and works out. He then shouts to the other WEIGHT LIFTERS.

SIMON

Hey!

SIMON gets ignored.

SIMON Why is everyone ignoring me?? Is everyone here shy or just plain rude?

The WEIGHT LIFTERS shake their heads in frustration.

SIMON

(internal monologue) Fine. I can't take this anymore. I'm going to take things into my own hands. I know how to test if he's the deaf guy.

SIMON drops the weight, and walks behind the FAMILIAR PERSON, casually.

## SIMON

BOO!!!!!!

The FAMILIAR PERSON trips up and crashes to the ground. SIMON covers his mouth in shock.

SIMON

Oh no.

The FP gradually picks himself up and stares through SIMON.

SIMON (nervously) Hi.

The FP goes red.

FAMILIAR PERSON Do you have a problem?

SIMON You speak very well for a deaf person...

Everyone in the gym stares at the two. Some RUNNERS leave the treadmill to do so.

FAMILIAR PERSON

What??

SIMON It's me! Simon!

FAMILIAR PERSON And who do you think I am?

SIMON

Pete?

A PERSONAL TRAINER (25) approaches the two.

PERSONAL TRAINER What's going on here?

SIMON I'm not sure to be honest.

FAMILIAR PERSON He shouted 'Boo!' right behind me, and made me fall off the treadmill!

The GYM MEMBERS say things like 'it's true!' and 'he's mad!'

PERSONAL TRAINER Would you like to apologise to the poor guy?

SIMON notices a MAN entering the gym who looks very similar to the FAMILIAR PERSON.

SIMON Hang on a second.

SIMON jogs to the MAN as the PT comments to the FP.

PERSONAL TRAINER What's he going to do now?

SIMON stares hard into the MAN's ear.

SIMON Wow... Hearing aids are really stealth nowadays, aren't they Pete?

The MAN scratches his head.

MAN My name is Jacob.

SIMON laughs.

SIMON

Good one!

SIMON then sticks his fingers into the MAN's ears.

In a panic, the PERSONAL TRAINER runs to the MAN.

PERSONAL TRAINER I'm so sorry! Is this your first experience here??

MAN

Yes!

PERSONAL TRAINER Dear God! What an introduction! Please, please forgive me!

MAN I don't feel safe here.

PERSONAL TRAINER I can assure you, this has never happened before!

A GYM MEMBER shouts across the room.

Me too!

GYM MEMBER It's happened to me!

Another MEMBER replies.

OTHER GYM MEMBER

SIMON I thought they were deaf!

PERSONAL TRAINER You thought they were deaf? So you harassed them?

SIMON I'd say it was more of an interrogation...

PERSONAL TRAINER Get out.

SIMON Okey dokey. Just let me do some press ups. I'm feeling agitated. I have been for a very long time.

SIMON does so.

PERSONAL TRAINER You're banned.

Everyone cheers.
