BEN: You're a sick man, Dan...

BEN: That's a surprisingly benign fantasy. Well done.

DAN: He's probably thinking about lasers that can turn people into kebabs, or something sick...

JAMES: You can't trick me. My thinking is clear as crystal.

DAN: Fine.
