Ben: NO!

DE: What? What's going on?

Ben: You weren't around at the time, but there was a pizza crisis a while ago, and people don't like talking about it...

DE: What do you mean?

Ben: People ate pizzas and turned into them. Now move on.

DE: Oh I am SO sorry!

Ben: It's ok, I just have some bad memories. I'll never forget the smell of the cremations. They smelt amazing.

(A phone rings)

Caller: Hello, it's your sponsor, Timmy's TNT. Not only is Dan a first rate bomber of James's house, Charlie's acting is dynamite, too. Therefore, how about I sponsor you as well?

Ben: Don't listen to him, all he does is give explosives to people, he's really shifty.

Caller: I am a man of few words and I deal with explosions and chaos. If that makes me shifty in your eyes, so be it.

Ben: Charlie, don't accept his offer. Imagine if someone asked you if you had a sponsor, and you said you were given TNT by a dealer who has enough explosives to blow up many small islands.

Caller: It would make him powerful.

Ben: Oh great, you're a TNT dealer who feels powerful not when he gets money, but when he's responsible for explosions, that's not dodgy at all.

Caller: Everyone is dodgy in some way, am I right?

Ben: Eh?

Caller: James likes numbers too much, you like the cheesy and doughy smell of pizzas who were once people, and I like the thrill of seeing things explode. If I'm shifty because I see my face in mushroom clouds, and that proves I am not man, but fire and chaos, so be it.

(Sellotape sounds)

James: you're the king!

Ben: And why is he the king?

James: I see my face in places too, but when I look in mirrors!

Ben: Oh, that's completely normal...

James: Sometimes I see my reflection in windows, too...

Ben: Again, normal.

James: Really? But windows are see-through...

Caller: Anyway, what do you say to my offer, Charlie?

Dan: I know the sponsor just ignored James which really is the best thing anyone could possibly do...

James (interrupting): Remember I can't speak with the sellotape, sometimes I don't really want to in hindsight...

Dan: But, there are better people to be sponsored by. Like Bill's Biscuits. Or Paul's Pens...

DE: The pen IS mightier than the sword... I could REALLY dominate someone with a pen...

Dan: There you go!

DE: Paul's Pens, please sponsor me...

Dan: You made the right decision.

Caller: That's too bad. Good day.

Ben: Oh no, we're nearly out of time. Sorry for talking about bombs more than your latest film, Charlie...

DE: It's ok. There isn't a lot to my film, really. There's plenty of fab dancing moves though, I'm not allowed to say what yet, but I can show the people here as long as you keep it a secret...

Ben: Go on...
