JAMES

What do you want me to do??

CAMERA MAN

Just be nice. At least be nice as I film you...

JAMES

And why do you have to film me, again?

CAMERA MAN

Proof. Because no one would believe you'd ever be nice!

JAMES

I see. I have some change in my pocket...

OAP 1

I'll have it!

JAMES hands the neighbouring OLD MAN the cash.

JAMES

No problem! Can I go now?

CAMERA MAN

Giving an old person a few coins just isn't going to cut it, James.

JAMES

Of course. Do you want my shoes?

CAMERA MAN

I don't think they'll fit them...

JAMES

They can sell them. Take my shoes.

JAMES takes his shoes off and hands them to the same OAP. The latter accepts them, smiling.

JAMES

Now can I qo?

CAMERA MAN

Not yet, no.

JAMES

Come on! I can't walk outside and have no money for the bus home! Haven't I suffered enough?

CAMERA MAN

No! And why is being kind so stressful for you??

JAMES

I'm taking my socks off! Please let things end there!

JAMES does so and places them on the same MAN'S legs.

CAMERA MAN

(sympathetically)

Did anyone ever say taking their socks off was an act of kindness to you, James?

JAMES

I worked it out for myself, Mr... What IS your name, anyway?

CAMERA MAN

Daniel.

JAMES goes white.

JAMES

(nervously)

Daniel, eh? Nice name.

CAMERA MAN

Thank you. Anxiety is contagious, you know? You're starting to make ME anxious. Look, I'll take a break and stop filming.

The CAMERA MAN takes a lighter and cigarette from his pocket and lights it up. JAMES fidgets, clearly very stressed.

CAMERA MAN

Are you ok?

JAMES

It's... ok. I just have a thing about people called Dan and starting fires, obivously. Never mind. I'll be fine.

CAMERA MAN

Do you want a cig?

JAMES

Isn't it illegal to smoke in these places?

CAMERA MAN

(laughing)

Don't worry. I won't film it.

The CAMERA MAN hands JAMES a lighter and cigarette.

JAMES

No thanks. I don't smoke.

JAMES tries to hand the items back but gets rejected.

CAMERA MAN

Keep them. Maybe you'll change your mind later.

JAMES

Ok . . .

OAP 1

I hate to interrupt, but my son should be visiting me soon. He works at the local petrol station, you know? He likes to bring me all sorts of wacky and crazy presents to really take me be surprise! He's been hinting that he'll be bringing me a bottle filled with petrol! He's such a character!

JAMES

I have to get out of here now. Please. Give me my shoes and socks back.

OAP 2

That's not very nice. And to think I was going to give you a World War 2 flamethrower I've had ever since my army days!

JAMES

I don't want it!!!

CAMERA MAN

Now, now, James. This isn't the kind of behaviour you need to be showing.

JAMES

I don't care, I have to get out of here!

A MAN carrying a clear bottle with a black liquid in enters the room. Everyone looks to him and cheers. The MAN cheerfully opens the container and throws the liquid all over the place.

OAP 1

Hahaha! Such a character!

JAMES

I don't understand what's going on...

OAP 2

No one does, but it's wacky!

MAN WITH PETROL

Who's that sour-faced man with no sense of humour?

JAMES

I'm called James...

MAN WITH PETROL

Next things you'll be saying you don't want my bottled chlorine trifluoride!

The CAMERA MAN chuckles.

CAMERA MAN

He doesn't want my cigarette or lighter, either! What's your name out of curiosity?

MAN WITH PETROL

I'm called Daniel...

CAMERA MAN

Ha! That's such a coincidence! Mine too!

JAMES grinds his teeth, looking like he's having a panic attack.

JAMES

MAN WITH PETROL
