LEADER

LEADER

Everyone boos.

LEADER
I know, right? Now, I don't want ANYONE here oversleeping and having an excuse not to fight, or you oversleeping and then being killed before you even know what's going on. That's why you've all been given lots of water to drink. It will make you get up earlier than usual so you can pee, and we'll all be ready for the attack!

Everyone cheers again.

LEADER
Now drink your water!

Everyone drinks from their bags.

LEADER

INT. TEEPEE - MORNING
