JIM: About capital cities?

HOST: Of course! Why do you think this show is called 'Capitals and Funny Hats'??

STAN: Go on then. Next question.

HOST: What's the capital city of Denmark?

(Buzzing sound)

HOST: Please get it right.

STAN: P.

HOST: The letter P?

STAN: Yes. But a capital P.

HOST: But Denmark starts with a capital D... And I asked what the Capital CITY was, not the Capital letter of Denmark. And saying that is a cliché anyway. JAMES: Oh no.

STAN: We all felt bad for you, then you turn against us, and for what? Greed??

JAMES: Yeah! Why are YOU here?

HOST: I wouldn't worry, Stan. Copenhagen was a one off, I'm sure. Next question: What's the capital city of Italy?

JAMES: THAT'S Rome!

HOST: A super close contest now!

JAMES: And Stan and Jim are going down, together!
