The screen shows a still picture of an EGG, wearing makeup and looking beautiful in her sunlit bedroom and sitting on her golden, king size bed. She looks up to the ceiling in deep thought. Writing fades into view saying 'Starring Charlie Baldwin and Wendy Roland'. It then fades away.

NARRATOR

(over the music and  
picture)

This Summer the love story of the century is coming, but a love story with a difference: The two lovers are eggs!! Two eggs from rival families who are forbidden from seeing each other. Will they ever find a way of escaping their feuding families? Find out in Romeo-Egg and July-Egg!

The harp music stops. Drawn out, deep and sinister strings play over the following scenes.

INT. GRAND ROOM - DAY

Here is a room of two storey-high, marble pillars and fancy red and gold carpets. Ostentatious paintings hang on the walls. One painting is of an egg looking thoughtful and wearing a crown. A 6 foot tall, human FATHER wearing robes (50) stands with his hands on his hips as he faces a bald EGG (roughly 5) who shakes in fear.

FATHER

Son, dearest Romeo-Egg, you are not,  
repeat NOT allowed to see July-Egg!  
I'm your father and you WILL obey me!

He notices the EGG seems to be hiding something behind his back.

FATHER

What's that behind you?

ROMEO-EGG

Just a book on how to be a good egg,  
that's all.

FATHER

Give it here, it's mine.

INT. DINING ROOM - DAY

A different human FATHER (50) but similarly dressed, sits at an equally impressive table featuring lit candles and antique cutlery. He faces a stunning EGG (also around 5).

Stained glass windows are on the left of the room, letting in the sunlight.

FATHER 2

July-Egg, for the last time Romeo-Egg is not the right egg for you. His family is filled with morons, thieves and nutters. Never liked them!

EXT. CLOUDY SKIES - DAY

Romeo-Egg and July-Egg are flying high in the sky. The harp music only gets more mushy.

ROMEO-EGG

What I would give to make this dream real!

JULY-EGG

Oh me, too! Why must our families fight each other so?

WENDY and ROLAND peck each other on the lips.

INT. DINING ROOM - DAY

More scary and deep strings play. The FATHER and EGG remain seated.

JULY-EGG

I've been dreaming about him again...

FATHER 2

Not that God awful, sappy dream with harp music?!

JULY-EGG

It's a bit excessive, maybe it makes other eggs feel frightened, but it just feels right!

FATHER 2

Look, I'm your father and I love you, but what you just talked about was really stupid! In fact, if you mention the dream again, I will charge you with obscenity!!

The EGG sighs.

FATHER 2

We are a proud family of elite men and eggs. What I can't have happening is two stupid eggs getting together and causing chaos!

INT. GRAND ROOM DAY - DAY

The FATHER and EGG are in the same position, but the former occasionally gazes at the book.

FATHER

Look, you're a five year old egg-man,  
now. You've by far outlived many of  
your fellow eggs and for that, I  
respect you. Most eggs don't make it  
past a few days, they're simply too  
delicious, I've even seen challenges  
on Youcube where people put whole  
eggs in their mouths and swallow  
them. Your age gives you a wisdom.  
BUT you're NOT wise getting involved  
with a family who hate things as  
harmless as stealing and petty crime  
in general!

The screen shows a picture of the two EGGS sitting next to  
each other and enjoying a picnic in a sunny field. Soft  
piano music plays.

NARRATOR

(talking over the  
picture and music)

So there you go, lots of arguing,  
lots of tension and lots of longing!  
Will the egg ever get his book back?  
Probably not, but find out anyway,  
this Summer!
