Jim is actually very nice! Perfect. Why did I have butlers in jail? Long story, but it only led to people disliking me more.

(A phone rings)

James: Yes?

PK15: Psycho Killer 15, here. I'm calling from jail.

James: What, you're calling illegally? Not a great start.

PK15: No, take that suggestion back right now.

James: Of course you're calling legally. Prisoners are often allowed phone calls. Probably not to call radio stations, but you're clearly an exception.

PK15: Right, first up, you've just disrespected the leader of the Hardcore 15 prison gang by calling its name 'dumb'.

James: But as you're not the leader of it, it doesn't matter. Wink, wink.

PK15: The prison gang is like a family. You hurt anyone in the family and you hurt me.

James: Oh come on. What, do you all pat each other on the head and hug? Because I've never seen that happen even the one time.

PK15: You pat your brother on the head?

James: Yes, my friends, too.

PK15: And it doesn't lead to any disagreements?

James: You know what? Actually it does.

PK15: Look, apologise to everyone in my gang, now!

James: This whole situation is extremely difficult for me. Can I get a butler to apologise to you on my behalf?

PK15: No, it has to come from you.

(James is heard crying)

PK15: In your own time.

James: This is really hard for me!

PK15: But you said you'd apologise to everyone, earlier!

James: Yes, but I didn't realise how hard it would be!

PK15: Apologise now!

James: S.... s.... sorry! Oh God, I'm going to have to hang up on him, that was unbearable.

PK15: Hang on, wh...

James: He's gone. Right, I'm not going to apologise to the other prisoner Jim, screw him.

(A phone rings)

Jim: Hi, Jim Smith, here.

James: Oh dear God no.

Jim: Where's my apology you promised me when in jail?

James: Ohhhh, I have an idea.

Jim: What?

James: This show is being recorded, so all I need to do is get someone to replay the apology I made to Psycho Killer to you, and that way I won't really need to apologise again. Can someone in the studio replay my apology to Jim here, please?

James: S.... s.... sorry! Oh God, I'm going to have to hang up on him, that was unbearable.

Jim: Don't you dare hang up on me.

James: Oh for flip's sake, that sample went on too long!

Jim: Eh?

James: Oh never mind. You're not calling illegally as well, are you? It's just that Psycho Killer using the prison phone, me hanging up on him and you calling on the

same phone 2 seconds later? I don't buy it.

Jim: Yes, that's what happened. Now apologise to me normally.

James: ...

Jim: Go on.

James: S.... s.... sorry! Oh God, I'm going to have to hang up on him, that was unbearable.

Jim: What?

James: You've played the whole sample again! I AM going to fire whoever made that blunder, you do know that don't you? SHORTEN IT!

Jim: What's going on?

James: I don't know! S.... s.... sorry! Oh God, I'm going to have to hang up on him, that was unbearable.

Jim: You do realise you've said that phrase four times now and in exactly the same way, it makes you sound mental.

James: Again, that wasn't my fault, I wouldn't worry. Look just accept my apology and move on. Please.

Jim: It wasn't an apology, it was you freaking out!

James: Ok fine, it was me freaking out, but it was an apology too. Bye! Right! Now I have to apologise to the army for trespassing in their base whilst wearing a dress. Team, you've had a very long time to make it sound like I'm apologising to someone without me hanging up on people and saying how unbearable the whole situation is. Do it now. You have five seconds.

James: ...

James: S.... s.... sorry! Oh God, I'm going to have to hang up on him, that was unbearable. Oh good, you've repeated the exact same phrase again. Well now you're all fired, happy?

(An phone rings)

James: Oh God.

General Grey: Hello, General Grey, here.

James: Hello. How are you?

GG: Not so good. You have tarnished my whole army by making it look very silly. I

want an apology.

James: S.... s.... sorry! Oh God, I'm going to have to hang up on him, that was unbearable.

GG: What was that?

James: Right, this is a huge (expletive) you to everyone in my team! You all suck and I mean SERIOUSLY. Do you think this is funny, is that what it is? Because I'm now in serious trouble with criminals AND a general!

GG: Lol.

James: Look, as a token of good will, you can have my dress, how's that sound? It's yours, and I say good riddance to it as well, as it has only brought me pain.

GG: Lol!

James: THAT'S an apology. Kind of. So there you go, now I can hang up on you as well. What a day! Right, I'm all out of time, so bye!
