Ah Badmotorfinger by Soundgarden, part of the soundtrack of PS1 game Road Rash, one of the best game soundtracks of all time! (The Tony Hawks games had good music, too). The only song I wasn't too keen on in the RR game was a track called 'Teeth Grinder' by Therapy? It goes 'in my sleep I grind my teeth'? I have done that a couple or so times, but for me to really enjoy the song, I'd have to grind a lot more. Right now I relate to it about as much as songs such as 'Baby' by Justin Bieber and the nonsense lyrics 'Oh-ooh-whoa-oh-oh-oh-oh' and 'baby, baby, baby, oh'. I was a baby once, but other than that, the lyrics don't speak to me. It doesn't even make sense, making things ten times worse. Would you believe the music in the LP isn't particularly scary? Again, that makes things worse. You think you can trust someone as they seem down to earth and calm(-ish) like the music of SG, then out of nowhere they scream gibberish in your face. Did you think I was being paranoid just then? Having Googled 'Badmotorfinger meaning' the SG guitarist said he liked the name because 'it was kinda aggressive'. :S

You know what I think the album should be called? Good Motor Finger, and I'd like the words to be whispered, too. Even if I didn't know what the person meant, I'd find it strangely comforting. Most of the song titles are at least relatively harmless, but I wouldn't want track name 'Slaves & Bulldozers' to be either shouted OR whispered to me. Here's a thought: Have you ever been in a garden WITHOUT sound? All gardens have sound! Say you visited a friend or whatever and after watching a bit of TV you're invited into his garden for maybe a barbecue, if there was no sound at all you'd be extremely surprised if not deeply troubled. We also have 'Strawberry Fields Forever' that gets changed to 'Strawberry Fields Finger' and lastly 'The Long and Winding Road' gets changed to 'The Long and Winding Finger'.
