OAP

OAP

JAMES smiles.

JAMES

OAP

Errr...

JAMES

Also, can you give me some money, please?

OAP

Errr...

JAMES

Please? For me?

Clearly nervous, the OAP gets out his wallet from his pocket and hands it to JAMES.

JAMES

We're friends now, right? Of course you won't go the police...

OAP

Oh yes, yes. Best of friends.

JAMES
