CHARACTERS

LIFT MECHANIC	20, tall and a little overweight. He has crazy eyes and a mental smile. He carris his spanner and hammer on his belt, his jeans and t-shirt are worn.
CUSTOMER NO. 1	20, in casual clothing. He is naive and friendly.
CUSTOMER NO. 2	A business man (30). He is very foolish.

FADE IN:

INT: HOTEL RECEPTION - DAY

Wallpaper is peeling and the floor tiles are cracked. Lighting is good, but its source is buzzing. A reception desk houses a credit card machine, and a microphone and speaker. By the speaker, are a number of buttons. The LIFT MECHANIC with his old clothes and equipment, stands behind the counter, with far doors, by both his sides. He also faces CUSTOMER NO. 1 (20). He is in casual clothing.

CUSTOMER NO. 1

Hello... This place is... really tacky.

LIFT MECHANIC

Don't worry, it's purely intentional. It's just the theme of the hotel.

CUSTOMER NO. 1

I understand. So what's cheapest room here, like?

LIFT MECHANIC

Not great...

CUSTOMER NO. 1

Oh. What about the mid range rooms?

LIFT MECHANIC

They still kind of suck..

CUSTOMER NO. 1

The best room?

LIFT MECHANIC

Not fit for cockroaches.

CUSTOMER NO. 1

Hmm. Well at least your honest!

LIFT MECHANIC

You like honesty?

CUSTOMER NO. 1

I'm sorry?

LIFT MECHANIC

The best room is not only unfit for cockroaches, turning the lights on might set you on fire, and the door doesn't work.

CUSTOMER NO.1 laughs, and his body language becomes more relaxed.

CUSTOMER NO. 1

(not believing him)

Wow. How much does it cost to stay in it for a couple of days?

LIFT MECHANIC

Around £600...

CUSTOMER NO. 1

Hahaha, that's great.

LIFT MECHANIC

It is?

CUSTOMER NO. 1

(laughing)

Sure! I'm feeling crazy. Book me your worst room, for 2 days!

LIFT MECHANIC

Ok, that will be £500...

CUSTOMER NO. 1

Sure it is!

CUSTOMER 1 hands the LIFT MECHANIC his credit card, from his pocket. He then puts in the PIN code.

CUSTOMER NO. 1

And how do I get to the hell hole?

LIFT MECHANIC

The stairs past that door, over there.

CUSTOMER NO. 1

Which one?

LIFT MECHANIC

The one you didn't just come out of.

The MECHANIC points to the correct exit.

CUSTOMER NO. 1

What floor is it on?

LIFT MECHANIC

Top floor. Lovely views of trains, but it's the most dangerous room. Hence the cheaper price.

CUSTOMER NO. 1

(laughing again)

It's dangerous?

LIFT MECHANIC

Kind of. What goes up, and all that...

CUSTOMER NO. 1

You don't have a lift to get ther...

LIFT MECHANIC

(cutting in)

NO!

CUSTOMER NO. 1

No?

LIFT MECHANIC

There were some legal issues involving the thing. All over now, though. But take the stairs, anyway...

CUSTOMER NO. 1

(laughing some more)

Oh, God! And what will happen if I take the lift?

LIFT MECHANIC

Ahem...

CUSTOMER NO. 1

What?

LIFT MECHANIC

You'll be fine... I guess... It's just scary, that's all. You might experience short lived peril.

CUSTOMER NO. 1

Well let me ride it, then! Life's all about experiences, right??

LIFT MECHANIC

I guess it's an experience to ride the lift. Hell, it might be the best experience of the rest of your life!

CUSTOMER NO. 1

Wow.

LIFT MECHANIC

Off you pop, then.

Completely oblivious to his potential fate, the CUSTOMER goes through the door.

LIFT MECHANIC

The MECHANICS twiddles his thumbs in boredom, and hums the Enter Sandman riff. Then, a voice sounds from the speaker.

CUSTOMER NO. 1

The MECHANIC speaks into the microphone, after dialing a number.

LIFT MECHANIC

CUSTOMER NO. 1

LIFT MECHANIC

Oh, shit. What's happened?

CUSTOMER NO. 1

The cables are creaking!

LIFT MECHANIC

LIFT MECHANIC

All of them? You have four to get through...

CUSTOMER NO. 1

CUSTOMER NO. 2

Definitely. I'm a huge risk taker.

LIFT MECHANIC

CUSTOMER NO. 2

Er... This is a hotel, right?

LIFT MECHANIC

Of course. But it's different, it's also a kind of casino. In a way. So... There is just one fruit machine-like lift here... And one rule...

Excuse me?

LIFT MECHANIC

The only rule is... There are no rules!

CUSTOMER NO. 2

That sounds fun... What do I have to do?
