Ah, reviews; a favourite subject of mine. Let's milk it like I milk everything. (In a good way, right?) I remember many, many years ago 'Infest' by Papa Roach getting a one star review. PR are at least kind of different to their contemporaries such as Limp Bizkit. Ok, in their song 'Last Resort' (not about holidaying as you might expect) they may have stolen their main riff from Iron Maiden and it's hard to take the anti materialism message in 'Between Angels and Insects' seriously. (The band lead a very luxurious lifestyle). Furthermore, the eerie guitar riffs in one song sound EXACTLY like Korn on one minor occasion, but a few small flaws and one massive rip off isn't something to be too worried about. This material is a lot of fun and as the singer says; his 'God-given talent is to rock all the nations'. Well, I'm not sure about TALENT, but he does rock at least a little bit.

Let's find some more lyrics to take this piss out of. Yeah, cool. Ok, this shouldn't be hard, what ones show up on Google? WTF is a 'lyrical pistol'? That's what the search engine gives me after my PR query. I'm not going to waste time analysing that, but it does sound kind of dumb. Not 1 star dumb, though. In another song we have 'cut my life into pieces, I've reached my last resort'... and it continues 'I'm contemplating suicide'. I'm sure your holiday you mention isn't THAT bad. Oh, sorry, that was my mistake as explained earlier. It's nothing to do with recreation, ignore those comments and get me some amnesia meds. Only joking, I think. The words 'process the data, make yourself the bomb' in another song really suck balls, though. If I did make myself turn into a bomb, I'd probably bomb the band to knock some sense into them and stop them talking gibberish. Of course, if it was possible for me to actually do so, their lyrics would be a lot less random, but it isn't, so they still suck. Ok, I think that's enough abuse. Now it's time for the summary....

All in all, ****ing stupid. Only joking, I'm exaggerating for comic effect (I hope!) All in all, this is fun. I know I've said that before, but it's good to be clear. What the hell was that one star review about? What happens when a record comes out from a band that can't play their instruments and everything's a complete mess? Believe it or not, I have such an album in my possession. Sure, no one has ever heard of it and it's so bad that it's extremely unusual, but still, THAT'S an album that deserves one star.
